STEP 1

Find the ALA in column N.

STEP 2

Vote **1** for the ALA **above** the thick black line.

STEP 3

Allocate preferences **above** the thick black line in this order:

- 1 Pauline Hanson's One Nation (column X)
- 2 Family First (column T)
- 3 Katter's Aust. Party (column I)
- 4 Shooters, Fishers & Farmers (column Q)
- 5 Liberal National Party (column G)
